Re: CEDAR TAC firmware upgrade requirement

- A new TAC driver is needed to run version 6.x. This can be installed in the usual manner. For further information on this, please refer to the Help files.
- A TAC firmware upgrade is also required before you are able to use the CEDAR Cambridge version 6.x software. This firmware will have to be rolled back should you wish to revert to a previous version of CEDAR Cambridge.

The CEDAR TAC firmware upgrade process:

When you run the CEDAR Cambridge V6 software for the first time the TAC firmware utility will automatically invoke, and there will be a set of on-screen instructions that will guide you though the firmware upgrade. Please follow these carefully. Contact support@cedaraudio.com if you encounter any problems, or if you wish to roll back your TAC firmware to a previous version.

Please note:

If your CEDAR Cambridge system was supplied in the spring of 2003 with v1 software and your current TAC firmware version is v1.1.1, it may currently be unsuitable for use with CEDAR Cambridge v4 onward. **Before** updating your CEDAR Cambridge system to v4 or later, please ensure that you have suitable

TAC firmware installed. You can check this by either of the following methods:

- Access Setup from the CEDAR Cambridge Process manager and select the TAC option. The firmware version will be displayed.
- Read the version information displayed on the TAC's LCD when you first switch it on.

If your TAC has version 1.1.1 firmware installed, we advise you not to install CEDAR Cambridge v4 or later, and that you return the TAC to us for upgrade.
